Don't Hog the Hedge! Hibernation Habitats

You will need:

- A paper plate
- A sheet of A4 paper (any colour)
- Various collage materials, tissue paper, real leaves, twigs, cotton wool, etc.
- Crayons/coloured pencils
- Glue

Instructions

- 1. Choose one of the animals from the Twinkl Original story 'Don't Hog the Hedge!' that you would like to make a hibernation home for. It could be a hedgehog, a toad, a dormouse, a bat or a queen bee.
- 2. Cut your paper plate in half.
- 3. Take one half of the paper plate and cut a small semicircle out of the middle of it.
- 4. Stick this onto your piece of paper (so the plate is face-down) so that it looks like a 3D cave.
- 5. Decorate the paper plate to make it look like the habitat your creature would hibernate in. For example, if you chose a hedgehog, decorate the plate so that it looks like a pile of dry leaves. You could stick real leaves and twigs over it.
- 6. Draw, colour or collage the background of the paper. You might like to create trees or hills, etc. You could even add cotton wool to make the scene look snowy.
- 7. Draw or collage your chosen creature and place it inside your paper plate habitat.
